Section 18-212: Shipping containers for storage

A. Use

- 1. Permanent shipping containers shall be used for storage purposes only.
- 2. Permanent shipping containers shall not be permitted as a principal building.

B. Quantity

- 1. A maximum of one permanent shipping container per site shall be permitted on lots of one acre or less.
- 2. One additional permanent shipping container per acre may be permitted for lots greater than one acre.

C. Dimensions and appearance

- 1. Containers shall not exceed the dimensions of 40 feet in length, eight feet in width, and 10 feet in height. Containers shall not be stacked vertically.
- 2. Containers shall be maintained in good condition free from structural damage, rust, and deterioration.
- 3. Containers shall be painted tan, brown, dark forest green, or light gray.
- 4. No signs or lettering shall be permitted on permanent shipping containers.

D. Location

- 1. Permanent shipping containers shall meet all building setback requirements and shall be located on the rear half of the lot.
- 2. Permanent shipping containers shall not be permitted in any parking areas, required buffers, setbacks, or loading areas.

E. Screening

- 1. Containers shall be screened from view from any right-of-way and any residential use.
- 2. At minimum, screens shall consist of a wooden privacy fence or a brick or stucco wall one foot taller than the container.
- 3. The exterior of the fence or wall shall be lined with foundation plantings that reach a minimum of three feet in height at maturity and spaced appropriately for the species which must be listed in the approved plantings list in the Technical Standards and Specifications Manual.
