# STUDY LIST APPLICATION LOCAL HISTORIC LANDMARK DESIGNATION

This application initiates **preliminary consideration** of a property for local historic landmark status. This does not mean that a property is being designated as a local historic landmark at this time, nor does this application constitute a local historic landmark designation form. This application will be reviewed by the Wilmington Historic Preservation Commission. If the property meets the minimum requirements (see attached) for consideration as a local historic landmark you will be notified by the Commission on how to continue the nomination process. **This application enables evaluation of a property to determine if it is likely to qualify as a local historic landmark.** 

Evaluation takes place as needed by the Commission; if approved by the Commission the property will be placed on the study list. Applicants will be notified of the Commission's action in writing. Once a property is approved for the study list, a formal application for local historic landmark designation may be prepared.

Please carefully consider the attached information which explains the minimum criteria to be considered as a local historic landmark property, and the subsequent effects of local historic landmark designation.
