BIASED BASED POLICING

The Wilmington Police Department is dedicated to addressing and removing biases from the act of law enforcement.

There were 13 complaints alleging biasedbased policing out of 46 citizen complaints filed in 2021. That's an increase of eight complaints from 2020.

Three of these allegations were traffic stops, while the others were investigative, routine patrol, and suspicious vehicle. All 13 were exonerated or unfounded.



Early Warning System

The Wilmington Police Department Professional Standards Division utilizes a multi-faceted Personnel Early Warning System (IAPro) to track use-of-force incidents, pursuit involvement, citizen complaints, internal investigations, officer-involved crashes, officer-involved injuries/fatalities, and departmental property losses. When an officer meets or exceeds the threshold for these incidents (set by the dept.), an alert is sent out to the first line supervisor and affected employee.

198

In 2020, Professional Standards sent out 198 alerts and all 198 were received.
