

LARGE VEHICLE PARKING INSTRUCTIONS

Parking of large vehicles, such as buses or RVs, are permitted to park in the 1100 block N. 4th St. between Swann and Nixon Streets, the 700 block of N. 2nd St. between Hanover and Hanover Streets, as well as the designated bus parking zones on 300 N. Water St. between Grace and Walnut Streets, and on the 00 block of N. 2nd St. between Market and Princess Streets. Simply park your vehicle on-street in the areas designated by signs.

According to City code a large vehicle is defined as:

...Any motor vehicle, tractor trailer unit, trailer, semitrailer, or towed vehicle, any characteristic of which equals or exceeds a width of seven (7) feet, an overall length of twenty-five (25) feet or a gross weight of two and one-half (2 1/2) tons.

Important: Vehicles that are being used for loading and unloading of goods can park free of charge in a designated Commercial Loading Zone, indicated by signage, for up to 2 hours in the downtown area. For example, a vendor delivering a product may park in any one of our Commercial Loading Zones and make their required deliveries throughout the downtown area so long as they are continuously loading/unloading within the allotted 2 hour limit.
