When rain falls on impervious surfaces (like roofs, roads, and sidewalks), it collects pollutants (like bacteria, fertilizer, and pesticides).

Those pollutants wash, untreated, into our waterways, such as Bradley or Hewletts Creek.

BMPs help to decrease the amount of polluted runoff entering our tidal creeks by soaking it in, spreading it out, and slowing it down.
