Native plants naturally protect local waterways, like Bradley Creek and Hewletts Creek. They are acclimated to local conditions, so they **do not need fertilizers or pesticides** which can harm aquatic ecosystems. Their deep roots help **filter pollutants** from stormwater runoff and **stabilize soil**. These **low-maintenance** and **drought-tolerant** plants also **provide food** for local birds, bees, and other pollinators!
