SPILLS: A SLIPPERY SITUATION

Oil, gasoline, and other fluids from our cars and boats can be a major problem for Hewletts and Bradley Creeks. In fact, a single quarter-sized drop of motor oil is all it takes to kill a sea bird. One quart of motor oil can contaminate 250,000 gallons of water! When it rains, any fluids that have fallen from a leaky car or boat get carried directly into our waterways.
