### Tips For a healthy and safe neighborhood

**Keep Grass Mowed** Front and back to the street.  
Rodents and other pests love tall grass, and weeds.



**Keep Shrubbery Cut**  
Back from streets and sidewalks.



**Get Rid of Trash**  
This includes litter, scrap metal and construction debris. Piles of trash and debris can lead to disease, injury or fire.



**Remove Junk Vehicles**  
Junk and broken-down vehicles are dangerous, especially to children.



**Keep Indoor Furniture,**  
Appliances and Electronics Off Porches and Yards  
Rodents and other critters love these too.



**Remove Hazardous Waste** from property  
i.e., tires, combustibles agents and batteries.



**Remove accumulation of water.**  
Containers that hold water  
contribute to mosquito problem in  
the area.



**Remove Graffiti**  
Urban Art and/or Tagging lowers property values and  
are unsightly in appearance



**Illegal Occupancy**  
Occupying dwelling without utilities, broken windows,  
promotes criminal activities.
