The Heal Our Waterways Program offers two funding programs for residents and businesses to install stormwater solutions like rain gardens, cisterns, wetlands, and more to help Bradley Creek and Hewletts Creek. ## Full Funding Program

Ideal for rain gardens, backyard wetlands, tree plantings, and cisterns. Projects are fully funded and coordinated in partnership with New Hanover Soil and Water Conservation District.



## Cost-Share Program

Up to \$10,000 in rebates available for large-scale treatment such as wetlands, infiltration basins, and permeable pavement. Commercial, mixed use, high-density, and HOA common areas are eligible. First-come, first-served.



## What are nature-based stormwater solutions and how do they benefit Bradley Creek and Hewletts Creek?



Nature-based stormwater solutions mimic the way natural spaces slow down, spread out, and soak in stormwater runoff. This helps treat and filter pollutants, like bacteria, before they can reach local waterways. Examples of nature-based stormwater solutions include rain gardens, infiltration basins, constructed wetlands, tree plantings, and permeable pavement.
